 - a. <u>American YouthWorks' Texas Conservation Corps HEAT Program.</u> Receive funding request for additional services/clean-ups for the District; and authorize all appropriate action.
 - b. <u>Clean-ups.</u> Receive update and review past and upcoming clean-ups in collaboration with Keep Houston Beautiful, Bike Houston, Houston Recovery Center, and City of Houston; and authorize appropriate action.
 - c. <u>Trash Bash.</u> Receive report on HGAC Trash Bash 2023 and volunteer opportunities and GNMD involvement; and authorize appropriate action.
