 - g. Clean-up Projects. Receive report on partnerships on various clean-up projects in the District.

- 12. **Reconvene in Open Session.** Reconvene in public session to consider authorizing District staff and consultants to take any action necessary with respect to (a) pending or contemplated litigation or attorney advice; (b) acquisition of real property; (c) personnel matters; and (d) receiving information from or questioning employees; (e) economic development negotiations or offers of financial incentives; (e) deployment of security personnel or devices or a security audit; and (f) any other matters relative to any of these matters which was discussed in Executive Session.
