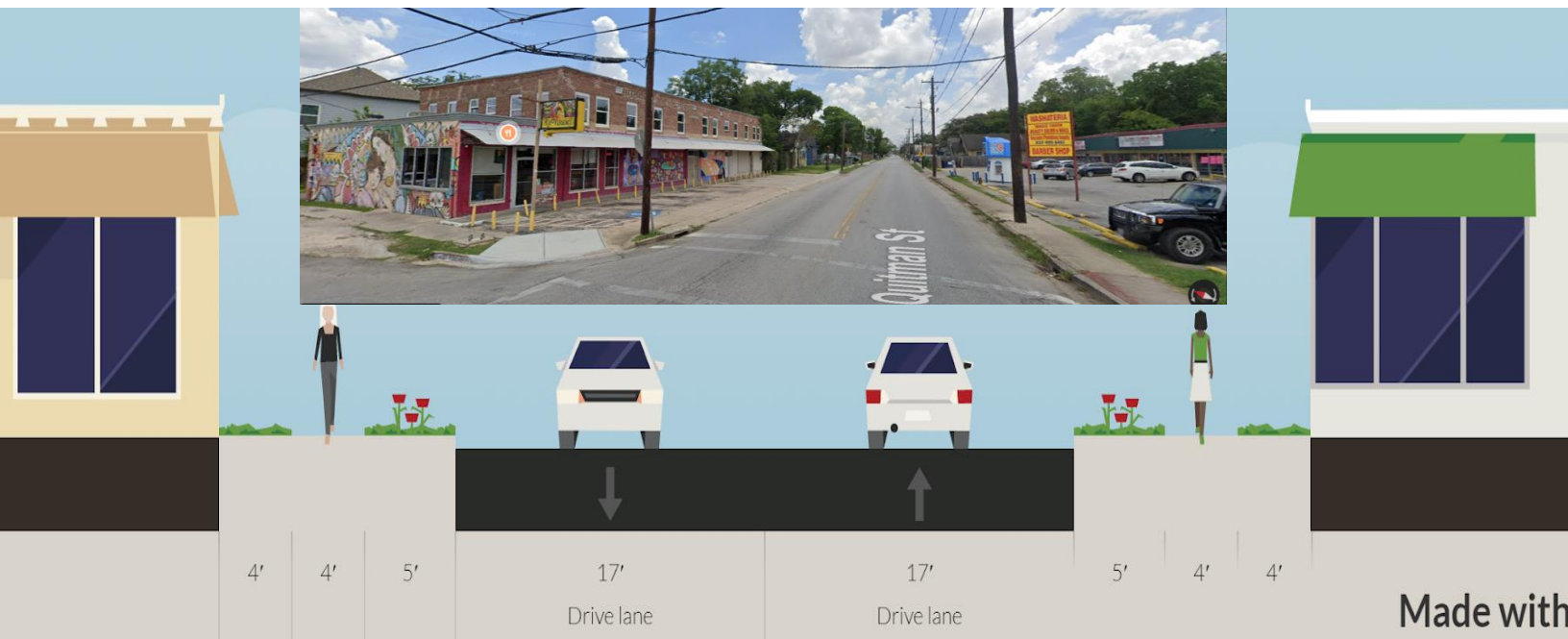

## PLANNING:

### Quitman St. Pedestrian Enhancement Project

#### Quitman Corridor History:

- [Northside Livable Center Study](#)
  - Identification and emphasis of the Quitman and Fulton Street area as the “heart” of Northside.
  - Recommendation: Encourage pedestrian and streetscape improvements along main north-south and east-west streets as well as streets within close proximity of new transit stations
- [City of Houston Heights-Northside Sub-Regional Mobility Study](#)
  - Future Vision: Given the area context and projected volumes of the corridor, it is recommended it be reclassified as a Major Collector and the multi-modal classification identified as an Urban Street
- [Greater Northside Management District \(GNMD\) Pedestrian/Transit Access Master Plan](#)
  - Pedestrian Level of Service (PLOS) Average Letter Grade of **D** from N. Main to Hardy Street
  - Recommendation to improve pedestrian infrastructure on corridors that have failing infrastructure. Install pedestrian-oriented lighting, ADA ramps and crosswalks, where needed.
- [GNMD received the H-GAC 2015 TIP Call for Project Funding for the Quitman Pedestrian Enhancements Project](#)
  - The project entails the (re)construction of sidewalks and the installation of pedestrian amenities such as curb/gutter, ADA ramps, and lighting along 0.72 miles of Quitman Street, from South Street to Gano Street.
  - The streetscape improvements along Quitman Street will enhance sense of place and preserve the cultural fabric by augmenting the overall quality of area.

- includes pedestrian and bike improvements from Houston Ave to Elysian St. It is a partnership among GNMD, Harris County Precinct. 2, METRO and the City of Houston. Intergovernmental Partnerships with METRO, the City of Houston and Harris County Precinct 2 has increased project scope from Houston Avenue to Elysian and project funding to **\$6,589,782**

- Increased Connectivity & Mobility, Safety for all modes of transportation (Traffic, Pedestrian, and Bike Riders), Transit Oriented Development and Ridership & Economic Development

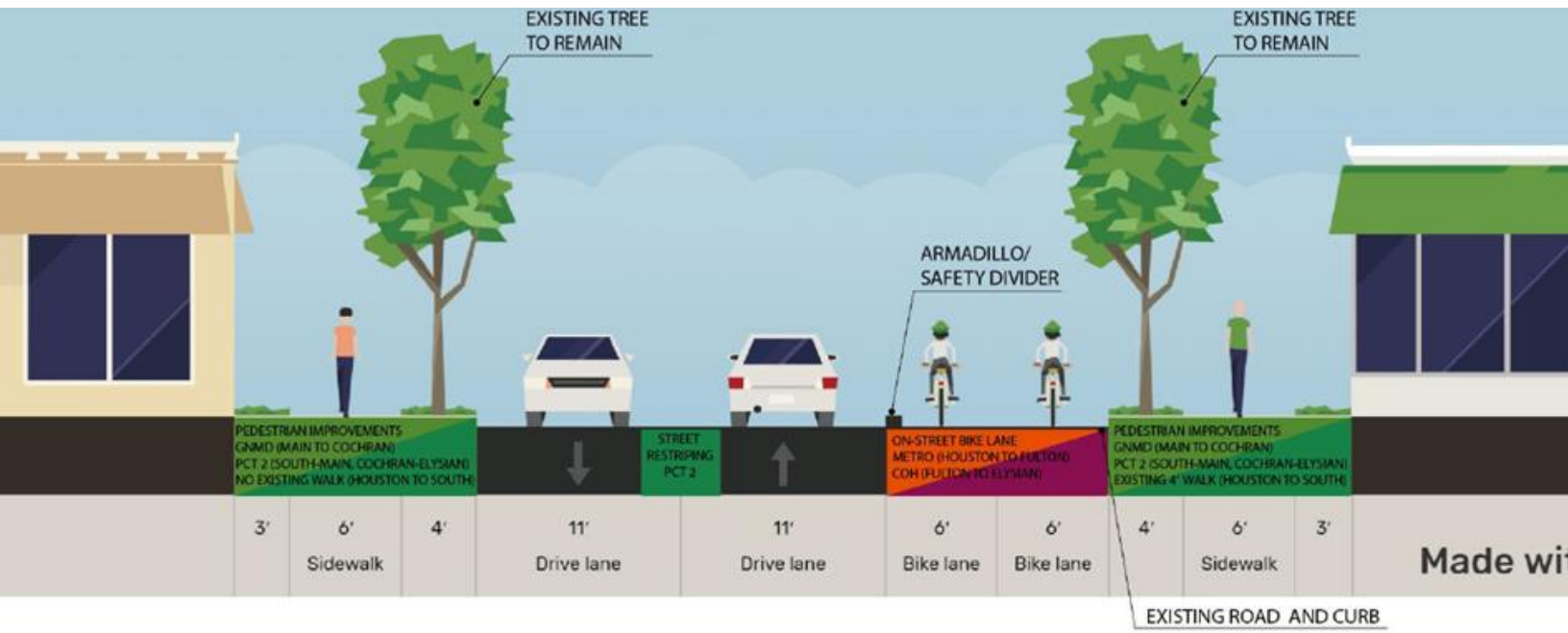

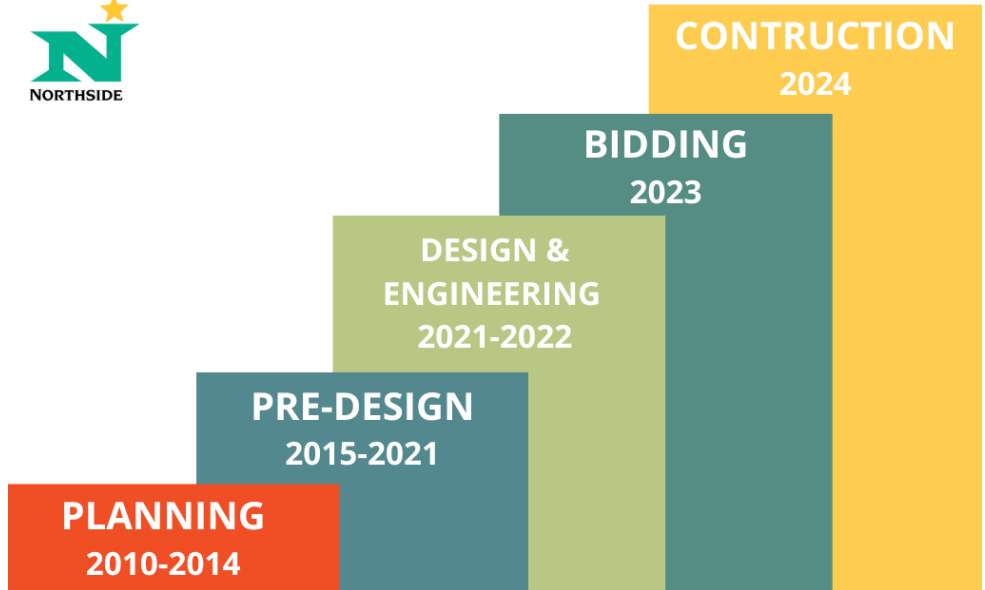
